Lessons for Lent & Life: from the writings of Mother Teresa of Calcutta

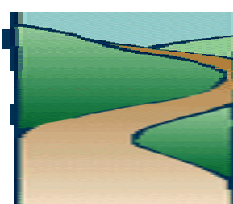
